



Dear Palm View Golf Course Patrons,

The health and well-being of our patrons and staff are of the utmost importance to us. To help slow the spread of Corona virus and protect our patrons and staff, the following SAFEGUARDS have been established effective Monday, March 22, 2021 for using the Palm View Golf Course facilities.

GENERAL SAFEGUARDS

1. Staff and patrons should adhere to the 6-foot social distancing rule in all areas of the Golf Course and at all times
2. Gatherings of any size and in any area of the golf course are strongly discouraged
3. Golf Course staff will continue cleaning facilities more diligently
4. Staff members are required to wear face coverings when interacting with customers or other staff members
5. We encourage all our employees and patrons to wash their hands frequently, avoid touching their face and observe proper hygiene
6. High contact areas such as entrance doors, check-in counters, restroom doors, faucets and flushers will be cleaned more frequently

BEFORE BOOKING A TEE TIME

Please note that:

- customers should leave the premises immediately after the round; socializing in any area of the Golf Course, including the parking lots is not allowed
- Ball washers are covered and continue out of service
- Bunker rakes have been removed and continue unavailable
- The air hose for cleaning shoes and other equipment before & after the round is not available
- **While on the course, CUSTOMERS MUST:**
 - always adhere to the 6-foot social distancing rule
 - play with the flagsticks “in” and must not touch the flagstick; holes have been modified for the golfer to play without the need to touch the flagstick
 - wash their hands as frequently as possible and avoid touching their face
 - avoid the traditional handshake at the completion of the round

TO BOOK A TEE TIME

- Pre-payment is highly encouraged
- Tee Times may be booked and paid Online at www.palmviewgolf.com or by calling the golf shop at 956-681-3444
- **Access to the Golf Shop will be only for customers unable to pay their fees Online or for merchandise purchases;** only 3 customers will be allowed in the Golf Shop at the same time
- When paying with a credit card, customers will be asked to swipe their own card
- Scorecards or pencils will be provided only upon request

CLUBHOUSE

- Only the main entrance doors and doors to the restrooms are closed; all other doors are open to avoid unnecessary contact
- **Customers must continue to wear a face covering for Clubhouse access**
- A Plexiglass sheet is installed at the Golf Shop Counter to protect customers and staff; sanitizer gel is also available

GOLF CARTS

- The Golf Course has a total of 70 golf carts
- **Carts will be issued based on “tee times”** and golfers are advised to plan their round accordingly to avoid having to wait for a cart on busy days
- The “two riders per cart” policy is effect again; an additional fee of \$6.47 plus tax will apply to golfers opting to ride alone
- Staff will clean and sanitize high contact points on our golf carts before and after each use (steering wheels, seats, side hand-rails and bag straps)

DINING ROOM

- “Dine-in” Food and Beverage service is now available for up to 50 customers at one time; curbside and carry-out service is also available
- Customers must wash or sanitize hands upon entering and exiting the Dining Room and when interacting with employees, other customers, or items in the restaurant
- Customers must always wear a mask except while seated at a table
- Customers **MUST NOT MOVE TABLES OR CHAIRS FROM THEIR PRE-SET POSITION**
- Maximum number of individuals per table is 6
- For orders, only 2 customers will be allowed to line up at the same time
- A Plexiglass is installed at the Counter to protect customers & staff; **sanitizer gel is available**
- The Beverage Cart will operate as usual but with the following precautions:
 - operator will always wear mask and gloves
 - operator will always adhere to the 6-foot social distancing guideline

Please note that these safeguards only serve as a guide and do not anticipate every situation; take actions based on wise judgement to help protect health and support economic revitalization.
